FOUNTAIN OF THE SUN COMMUNITY ASSOCIATION FOUNTAIN OF THE SUN HOMEOWNERS ASSOCIATION JOINT BOARD RESOLUTION REGARDING INTENT TO PURSUE MERGER

WHEREAS, the Fountain of the Sun Homeowners Association ("FOSHA") was created in 1972 as the nonprofit Arizona corporation Fountain of the Sun Association (later renamed as "Fountain of the Sun Homeowners Association" in 1994) for the benefit of the Fountain of the Sun community at large and in order to enforce its covenants, conditions and restrictions as well as maintain and administer its common areas and facilities;

WHEREAS, the Fountain of the Sun Community Association ("FOSCA") was created in 1983 for the transfer of and continued maintenance and operation of Fountain of the Sun development common facilities in accordance with the reasonable expectations of the residents and property owners of the community;

WHEREAS, on December 31, 1983 an Agreement was made between FOSCA and FOSHA (collectively, the "Associations") and the other councils and co-owners of the Fountain of the Sun development with respect to the transfer and continued maintenance and operation of its common facilities (the "1983 Agreement");

WHEREAS, the Associations recorded an Amendment to the 1983 Agreement on March 2, 2005 adopting a provision with respect to the payment of an "Impact Fee by its homeowners pursuant to the Agreement (the "1983 Amendment");

WHEREAS, the Associations formed a joint Ad Hoc Committee for the purposes of exploring and performing its due diligence regarding a potential merger of both Associations;

WHEREAS, having performed their due diligence through the Ad Hoc Committee, the Associations now desire to pursue merger of FOSCA into FOSHA and to that end, further amend their governing documents and the 1983 Agreement to accomplish such merger;

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED:

The Associations intend to move forward with the merger of FOSCA into FOSHA. In order to facilitate the intended merger, the Associations will pursue the following actions as the Boards deem necessary (along with additional actions if deemed necessary by the Boards):

- (1) Both Boards will review and adopt a Plan of Merger pursuant to the Arizona Nonprofit Corporation Act;
- (2) The Associations shall submit the Plan of Merger to its members for approval;
- (3) FOSCA will seek to amend its Bylaws and Articles of Incorporation to address the distribution of property to FOSHA and the dissolution of FOSCA;

WHEREAS, having performed their due diligence through the Ad Hoc Committee, the Associations now desire to pursue merger of FOSCA into FOSHA and to that end, further amend their governing documents and the 1983 Agreement to accomplish such merger;

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED:

The Associations intend to move forward with the merger of FOSCA into FOSHA. In order to facilitate the intended merger, the Associations will pursue the following actions as the Boards deem necessary (along with additional actions if deemed necessary by the Boards):

- (1) Both Boards will review and adopt a Plan of Merger pursuant to the Arizona Nonprofit Corporation Act;
- (2) The Associations shall submit the Plan of Merger to its members for approval;
- (3) FOSCA will seek to amend its Bylaws and Articles of Incorporation to address the distribution of property to FOSHA and the dissolution of FOSCA;
- (4) FOSHA will seek to amend its Bylaws and Articles of Incorporation to address Board transition, expansion issues, and potentially adopt a new corporate name, etc.;

- (5) The Associations will amend the 1983 Agreement to reflect the merged entities' obligations and duties;
- (6) FOSCA will convey its property to FOSHA—both real and personal property; and
- (7) After the merger is completed and the above work is accomplished, FOSCA will be dissolved and FOSHA will assume its responsibilities under the 1983 Agreement regarding the maintenance of common facilities.

The Associations further acknowledge that the above such actions will need to be taken, in addition to potential other actions, and that several such actions will be contingent on the successful undertaking of other preceding actions in order to facilitate the successful merger of the two Associations.
